

MINUTES
Lefors City Council Meeting
May 18, 2026 - Regular Session

Mayor Pro-Tem Savannah Kingcade called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Present were Council members Ashley Miller, Jerry Stegall, and James Gee. Mayor Michael Ray was absent.

Mayor Pro-Tem Kingcade led the Pledge of Allegiance. Councilman Gee said the Invocation.

Citizen Rick McMullen addressed the Council regarding the fact that there are prairie dogs in the cemetery and they are causing damage.

City Judge Kurt Curfman submitted a written report: For the month of April 2026, we had receipts of \$176.00. There were no new complaints or citations filed with the Court. At this current time, we have an outstanding balance of fines and court costs due to the City of Lefors of \$0.00 plus warrants of \$8,777.00. All local, state, and federal reports are current at this time.

Public Works Director Chad Young submitted a written report: The 2-inch water main serving Mike Steele's property was replaced. The isolation valve on this line has since begun leaking and will need to be excavated and replaced. The black truck has been returned from Scott; however, the transmission requires replacement due to severe slipping in first and second gear. Work orders are being addressed as they are received. The mapping team will begin town mapping at 8:00 a.m. and is scheduled to remain on site through Friday.

Councilwoman Miller made a motion to approve the consent agenda including reports, minutes from the April 20, 2026, regular meeting, and bills to be paid. Councilman Gee seconded. Vote unanimous. Motion passed.

City Secretary, Lindy Forsyth, swore in unopposed elected Council members Savannah Kingcade and James Gee. (Also elected were unopposed Cemetery Committee members Rick McMullen, Billy McBee, and Morgan McBee.)

Councilman Stegall made a motion to appoint Savannah Kingcade as Mayor Pro-Tem. Councilwoman Miller seconded. Vote unanimous. Motion passed.

No action taken regarding signatories at UMB Bank and the Lefors Credit Union.

Councilman Stegall made a motion to appoint Mayor Michael Ray and Councilwoman Ashley Miller to the Cemetery Committee. Councilman Gee seconded. Vote unanimous. Motion passed.

Councilwoman Miller made a motion to accept the proposal from FirstBank Southwest as the bank depository for the City. Councilman Stegall seconded. Vote unanimous. Motion passed.

Councilwoman Miller made a motion to adjourn. Councilman Stegall seconded. Vote unanimous. Motion passed.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:31 P.M.
