

MINUTES
Lefors City Council Meeting
January 12, 2026 - Regular Session

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Michael Ray. Present were Council members Savannah Kingcade, James Gee, Ashley Miller, Jerry Stegall, and Aaron Hunt.

Mayor Ray led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilman Gee said the Invocation.

There were no comments from citizens.

City Judge Kurt Curfman presented written reports: For the month of December 2025, we had receipts of \$123.00. There were no new complaints filed with the Court. Currently, we have an outstanding balance of fines and court costs due the city of \$200.00 plus warrants of \$8,777.00. All local, state, and federal reports are current.

Public Works Director, Chad Young, was absent due to a water leak.

Councilman Hunt made a motion to approve the consent agenda which included minutes from the November 17, 2025, regular meeting, bills, and department reports. Councilwoman Miller seconded. Vote unanimous. Motion passed.

Councilwoman Miller made a motion for the City to pick up non-resident trash at a flat rate of \$75.00 a month, the City will supply the dumpster and pick up weekly, a two year contract agreement will be signed by the customer and the City, and an agreement will be drawn up by City Attorney Rick Harris. Councilman Hunt seconded. Vote unanimous. Motion passed.

Councilwoman Miller made a motion to replace the siding material on the south side of the old marshal's office. Councilman Stegall seconded. Vote unanimous. Motion passed.

A discussion was held regarding the possible dissolution of the City Marshal position.

Councilwoman Miller made a motion to remove equipment from the marshal car and use the car as a regular city vehicle. Councilman Stegall seconded. Vote unanimous. Motion passed.

Councilman Hunt made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Councilwoman Miller seconded. Vote unanimous. Motion passed.

The meeting adjourned at 7:19 p.m.
